Fon du Lac Park District's Men's Basketball Rules/Regulations

Basic Information

- Location: Eastside Centre
- Address: 1 Eastside Drive, East Peoria, IL 61611
- Season will start on June 4 – August 13; Playoffs will be August 20 ; The weekend of July 2, there will be no games
 - The number of games will depend on how many teams are in the league
 - Minimum of 10 games not including playoffs
- 5 vs. 5 with 3 subs each team (total of eight players per team)
- There will be two, 20 minute halves with running clock until the final 2 minutes of each half. Each team will receive two timeouts for each half (One full timeout and one 30 second timeout).

COST

- A flat rate of \$350 for a team.
- Roster will be due by May 30.
- Team captains have one week to adjust the roster.
- Team may go to local businesses for sponsorship to help pay for fee.
- Teams can purchase their own team shirts. THEY WILL NOT BE PROVIDED.

ROSTER AND ELIGIBILITY

- Players must be 18 years old to play in all leagues and they must be out of high school.
- Players and coaches that have college players on their team must check with NCAA and NJCAA eligibility guidelines. Fon du Lac Park District is not responsible for violations. The Park District will also cooperate fully with any information needed from any of the above listed associations or schools.
- If a team does not have a full roster (8 players on a team), they have until week three of the regular season to fill the roster
- Roster will be due by May 30.
- Each player must sign the roster sheet and pay the correct player fee before playing in any game.
 - A player that is added after the roster submitting deadline must do so before he or she plays. Eligible to play same night that you pay.
 - There is no late fee to add a player.

- All player additions must be made in person at the Fon du Lac Park District Administration Center or to Rocky Boyer the Fon du Lac Park District Sports Coordinator before game time.

SUBSTITUTIONS, ILLNESSES AND INJURIES

- Substitutions will be handled just like the IHSA handles basketball games.
- If a team has five players on a team and a player either fouls out or is injured to where they cannot play in the game. The team may finish with four players on the court.
- If a team has five players on a team and a player is ill the day of the game, the team may bring one player to replace him for that day.
- If a team does not have a full roster (8 players on a team), they have until week three of the regular season to fill the roster

PLAYOFF FORMAT

- The number of teams in the league will determine how many teams will be in the playoffs.
 - Example: if 10 teams are in it, 8 will make it with the top two teams having a bye
- The playoffs will be single elimination until the Semi-Finals.
- The winners of the two semi-finals games will play in a championship game while the losers will play in a 3rd and 4th place game.

FORFEITS

- There is no forfeit fee.
- **TEAM SUSPENSION:** A team is suspended from further league play after their third forfeit.
 - A forfeit that takes place after a game starts does not count toward the total amount, unless involves player eligibility.
- Failure to meet eligibility rules will result in a forfeit.
- Failure to adhere to a referee's decision or warning will result in a forfeit.
- Game time is forfeit time.
- A referee reserves the right to forfeit or double forfeit a game due to a team or teams conduct.
- If a team does not meet the minimum number of eligible players for a game it will result in a forfeit.

CONDUCT

- Any player, coach, spectator, or person associated can be prohibited from further league activity at the discretion of the Sports Coordinator at the Fon du Lac Park District.
- It is the team captain's responsibility to control the conduct of the team.
- Any team, coach, person affiliated with the team that is ejected from a game must sit out one or two games (depending on the severity).

ALCOHOL AND DRUGS

- Alcohol and drugs are not permitted in the Park District.
- Players, coaches or spectator under the influence will be forced to leave the park and/or arrested.

RULES

- There will be 2 refs at every game
- **ALL IHSA** rules will be applied and enforced during the games
