

# Youth Recreational BASKETBALL Program



## Divisions:

**5 year olds & Kindergarten / 1<sup>st</sup> Grade** (COED Division) – 27.5” basketball

- ◆ This division plays only on Saturdays in December, January and February at Armstrong School.
- ◆ Coaches will work with children on fundamentals prior to each game.
- ◆ This division concentrates on basic skills and developing a knowledge for rules of the game.
- ◆ This division begins December 1<sup>st</sup> and goes through February. Must be 5 years old by December 1<sup>st</sup>.

**2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> grade** – 28.5” basketball – 10’ baskets

- ◆ This division will have separate boys & girls teams.
- ◆ Boys Division will have Practices and Games held at EastSide Centre from November through mid January.
- ◆ Girls Division will have Practices at EastSide Centre through mid January and Games will be held at EastSide or at times will play games against other area recreational leagues on Saturdays (some travel involved).
- ◆ Teams typically practice one day per week (starting week of Nov 12<sup>th</sup>) and play games on Saturdays (Starting Dec 1<sup>st</sup>).
- ◆ Practices and games after mid January will be at local school gyms (TBD).

**4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> grade** – 28.5” basketball – 10’ baskets

- ◆ This division will have separate boys & girls teams.
- ◆ Boys Division will have Practices and Games held at EastSide Centre from November through mid January.
- ◆ Girls Division will have Practices at EastSide Centre through mid January and Games will be held at EastSide or at times will play games against other area recreational leagues on Saturdays (some travel involved).
- ◆ Teams typically practice one day per week (starting week of Nov 12<sup>th</sup>) and play games on Saturdays (Starting Dec 1<sup>st</sup>).

**6<sup>th</sup> - 8<sup>th</sup> grade** – 29.5” basketball (regulation size) – 10’ baskets

- ◆ This division is made up of boy teams.
- ◆ These teams will have Practices at EastSide Centre through mid January and Games will be held at EastSide or at times will play games against other area recreational leagues on Saturdays (some travel involved).
- ◆ Teams typically practice one day per week (starting week of Nov 12<sup>th</sup>) and play games on Saturdays (Starting Dec 1<sup>st</sup>).
- ◆ Practices and games after mid January will be at local school gyms (TBD).

**SKILLS EVALUATION DAY** at EastSide Centre: Saturday, November 3<sup>rd</sup> (10:00 - Noon)

All players grades 2<sup>nd</sup> - 8<sup>th</sup> grade need to attend. This day is a must for players so teams can be picked evenly. Park staff will evaluate all players so coaches need not attend. Come any time between 10:00 - Noon.

**DRAFT DAY** will be Thursday, November 8<sup>th</sup>. Only coaches need to attend to select players. The draft will be held at the Park District Administration Center at 6:30pm.
