- This program is held indoors and each age division plays twice a week on EastSide Centre's Turf Gym Floor.
- This is a Co-Ed program.
- Each date will consist of 15 minutes of skill development drills and then 45 minutes of game play.
- Most referees will be from ICC Men's Soccer Team. Parents will be needed to coach teams.
- All participants are required to wear shin guards with socks over top and athletic style tie-up tennis shoes (no cleats).
- All participants will receive a t-shirt and some great instruction on the fundamentals of soccer.
