Once registered for camp you have the option of paying in person, over the phone or online through our EPAY service. Registration begins Tuesday, May 3rd. First week of camp payment is due at the time of registration to hold your spot.

REQUIREMENTS:

- ◆ Child must have completed kindergarten up to those entering 6th grade.
- ◆ Both Residents and Non-residents of Fon du Lac Park District are eligible.

3 CAMP GROUPS:

Hakuna – entering 1st - 2nd grades | Matata – entering 3rd - 4th grades | Mufasa – entering 5th - 6th grades

CAMP TIMES: **June 6th - August 5th, 2022**

- ◆ Open at 6:30am | Close at 5:30pm
- ◆ Regular Camp Hours (8:30am - 4:15pm) | Extended Camp Hours (6:30am - 5:30pm)
- ◆ Drop off and pick up your child at the Fon du Lac Park District Administration Center
- ◆ We require all children to be signed in and signed out of camp.
- ◆ We charge **\$2 per minute** if late picking up your child.

IMPORTANT CHILD SAFETY – If someone other than yourself (person who registered your child) will be picking up your child, you must notify us. That person must also be listed on your child's "Participant Information Form". We will ask for identification of those we do not recognize.

REGISTRATION: **Registration begins Tuesday, May 3rd @ 6:30am**

Complete the attached Participant Information Form and return to Fon du Lac Park District Administration Center. **A non-refundable \$20 Registration Fee is due with each child's registration.** This fee is required before your child will be registered. **Registration must be done in person with registration form (no online registration accepted).** Once this has been completed you can pay for days or weeks of camp in person, over the phone or online using **EPAY**.

Note: To attend summer camp you must have your child registered no later than 5:00pm on Friday prior to the upcoming week your child is starting. Once registered, payments for upcoming weeks must be made by 5:30pm Fridays if in person or over the phone or by midnight Friday night on EPAY. **A \$15 late fee will be charged if paid after this time.**

FEES:

Camp fees include *most* field trip fees, admissions, bus transportation, activity supplies and lots of fun. We accept Cash - Checks (make payable to Fon du Lac Park District) - VISA/MC/DISCOVER.

Week Rates & Hours:

Regular Hours: 8:30am-4:15pm \$120 per week
Extended Hours: 6:30am-5:30pm \$140 per week

***Multi-Child Discount:** Applicable when additional members of household are enrolled for the **same week**. First child must be paid at full rate before discount can apply.

Daily Camp Rates: \$35 / day - offered for those that do not need an entire week of camp.

Child Care Connection - Subsidy Participants: An approval letter is required at the time of registration. Full payment is required upfront. Once the Park District receives reimbursement payment, then refunds will be issued.

REFUNDS: Refunds must be requested the week prior to attending. Missed days may not be applied to future weeks.

MEALS & SNACKS:

- ◆ Breakfast: We provide a small breakfast snack until 8:00am
- ◆ Lunch: Children need to bring their own sack lunch (nothing that needs heating or refrigerated)
- ◆ An afternoon snack is provided around 3:00pm



MEDICAL INFORMATION AND MEDICINE:

Please make sure all information is current on the "Participant Information Form" in regard to your child's medical conditions, medications, and if our staff must administer your child medication during the day. Any medication that must be given out at camp by our staff must be in the appropriate prescription bottle with a doctor's note.

FUN FRIDAYS:

Fridays are designed for Special Events or Field Trips. If a field trip is scheduled you may send money for souvenirs/snacks. Please send money in a plastic zip-loc style bag with your child's name on it. Please do not send any toys on Fridays and make sure your child is at the Administration Center by 9am. THESE TRIPS ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE & MAY BE DURING THE WEEK AS WELL.

CLOTHING:

Older, comfortable, but appropriate clothes are best for summer camp. There are times your child will get dirty and/or sweaty. Please bring a swim suit and an extra change of clothes for your child everyday as we want to do more water activities with the children. Sandals and/or flip-flops are only allowed on Pool days. You may put a pair in their book bags for water days. Closed toed shoes must be worn all other days to camp.

TOYS:

Please be aware that any toy/game brought from home is the child's responsibility throughout the day. The Park District is not held responsible for items that are lost or broken. If your child does bring something from home please label that item with your child's name. We strongly discourage electronic games and/or phones be brought to camp. No toy weapons of any kind are allowed.

WHAT TO BRING:

Please make sure your child has a book bag, lunch, and water bottle with them everyday! In their book bag please make sure there is an extra change of clothes and a jacket just in case.



DISCIPLINE:

Children are expected to have cooperation skills, self-control and respect for others. Unacceptable behavior such as bullying, bad language, fighting, and talking back to counselors will be dealt with immediately. Depending on the situation, campers may lose certain privileges such as Friday Field trips, attending Pool Days, or the child could be suspended for a period of time. The camp director will inform parents if any disciplinary action was taken either immediately or at the end of the day depending on the severity.

In situations of behavior that the Park District considers extreme, campers may be suspended and/or dismissed from camp immediately without prior written or verbal warnings. **Dismissal from summer camp also includes dismissal from our latchkey program for one year.** No refunds are issued in these cases for future days or weeks paid.

FAMILY-CUSTODY SITUATIONS:

The parent that registers their child for summer camp is responsible for payment. That parent is also responsible to add/cancel any persons on the "Participant Information Form" when situations arise. If there are custody papers that pertain to your child while attending our camp, we request a copy of those papers. If we have any issues we will contact our Fon du Lac Police for assistance.

COVID PROTOCOLS:

The Park District adheres to the School District's guidelines for both students and employees on your child's health to participate. Masks will be optional. We do ask if your child is not feeling well to please keep them home. If anything changes with the protocols we will keep everyone up to date!
