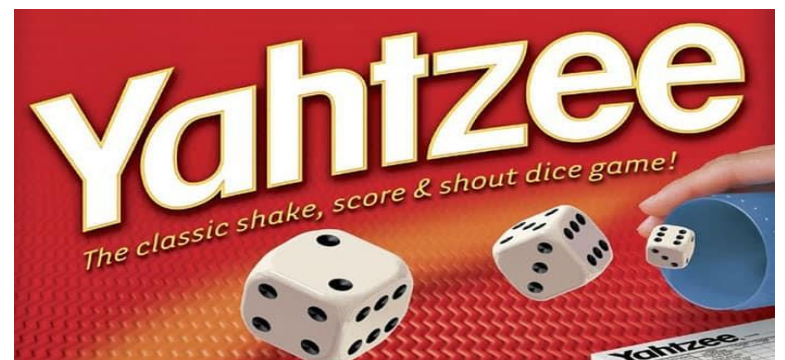

Bishop Hill Colony was started in 1846 by Swedish immigrants. 18 pre-Civil War buildings are still in use today as museums, businesses, and more. Discover and explore the fascinating history of Bishop Hill and surrounds, by visiting one or all 7 museums created and maintained by these organizations. The artifacts and buildings are original to the town and many of their residents are descendants of original settlers.

The Central Illinois farm where Lois and her husband Creel reside has been their home and livelihood for over fifty years. Perched along the Spoon River valley, their property bears more resemblance to a diverse wildlife preserve than to the agricultural model on which it was founded. With prairie and woodland, streams carpeted by stone, and a legacy of sensitive farming practices, the farm, now known as Hummingbird Haven, is a sanctuary devoted to the wild occupants that it benefits.

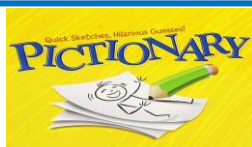

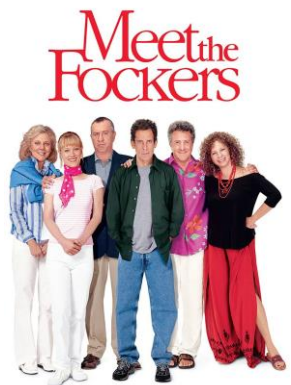
